
Thanet Coast Project - Public Events 2025

Newgate Gap, Cliftonville (CT9 2GA)



The event involves a 7 minute walk along the grassland to a new base at the start of the Northern Sea Wall on the west side of Minnis Bay. High Tide beach cleans will not clean around the lagoon and shingle beach adjacent, as there are hightide bird roosts located here and so we can avoid disturbance.
